Andrea Pietrabissa was born in Pisa, Italy, where he received his medical degree in 1984. He continued his education as a general surgeon at the University of Pisa and subsequently at the University of Chicago as research fellow: 1986-88. He trained in MIS at Ninewells Hospital, Dundee, Scotland, under the chair of Prof. Sir Alfred Cuschieri, in 1992-93. Appointed ad Associate Professor of Surgery at the University of Pisa in 2000, he became Full Professor of Surgery at the University of Pavia in 2010, where he currently serves as Director of General Surgery and Head of the Department of Oncology. He is the current President of the European Association for Endoscopic Surgeons (EAES). His main research interest has always been in the field of technology for surgery. He is author of more than 145 peer-review articles with an H-Index of 32. He is fellow of the American College of Surgeons (ACS) and of the European Surgery Association (ESA). Honorary member of the Malta Surgical Society and of the Korean Society of Endoscopic and Laparoscopic Surgeons (KSELS).
